## Some of our success stories...

 agricultural techniques, seeds, tools and livestock for orphans and women all living with HIV in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

For many poor communities in India, access to safe, clean drinking water is a luxury not all can afford. We funded a project providing 100 beneficiaries in 5 villages with water purifiers. A training session on water and sanitation issues is also planned.

Every child deserves the opportunity to gain a basic education. In this project, we provided funding to build, equip and maintain a school in Laos.
