On Friday the 8th of November 2013, a typhoon of unprecedented scale ravaged the Philippines, causing massive destruction and hundreds of deaths, with dramatic social and economic consequences for the 7 million people affected and 600 000 persons displaced by the disaster. Entire towns have been razed. Humanitarian aid and emergency services are moving in on the ground and international solidarity is mobilising to help the wounded, and provide food, shelter, care and medication as fast as possible, and work on the rehabilitation and reconstruction.
